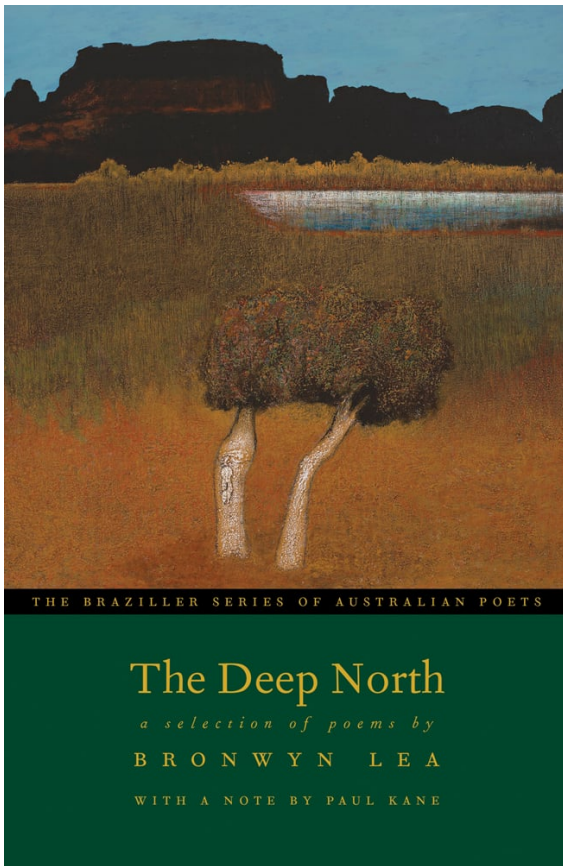




# Deep North: A Selection of Poems
